Carstens graduated from Iowa State University with a bachelor's degree in Agricultural Business. His passion for agriculture developed on his family's farm and has only deepened after spending years in the industry. He and his wife Shanda have three children (Claire, Camden & Carolyne) and reside in Grimes, IA.
