Meet the Professor: Dr. Katie Harris-Lagoudakis; Assistant Professor of Economics

Professor Harris has been an Assistant Professor of Economics at Iowa State University since 2019. She earned her Ph. D. and Masters in Economics from Michigan State University and her Bachelors in Economics from the University of Missouri.

Dr. Harris's research interests are in public, health, and industrial organization.
