Meet the Prof: Kelsi Guinn introduced President Steven Leath, Iowa State University's newest president. He knows there are over 800 clubs on campus, but he was glad to attend. He is a plant pathologist, like his father. President Leath has always been a land-grant guy. Coming to us from North Carolina State University, he enjoys extension work and teaching. He's more of an opportunist than a planner; he wanted to be a dean of a land grant college and now he is the president of a land grant university. He encourages student to "Think Big".
