 - Ag Bus major

 - Nominees give 1-3 minute talk
 - Maximum of 2 position slides allowed (including max of 1 slide up)

 - 3rd vote- vote on remaining for 2nd position

 - o 1st vote- 10- 1/2 advance
 - o 2nd vote- candidate with most votes wins
 - o 3rd vote- vote on remaining for 2rd position
