WHEN: Saturday October 10, 2009-8:30

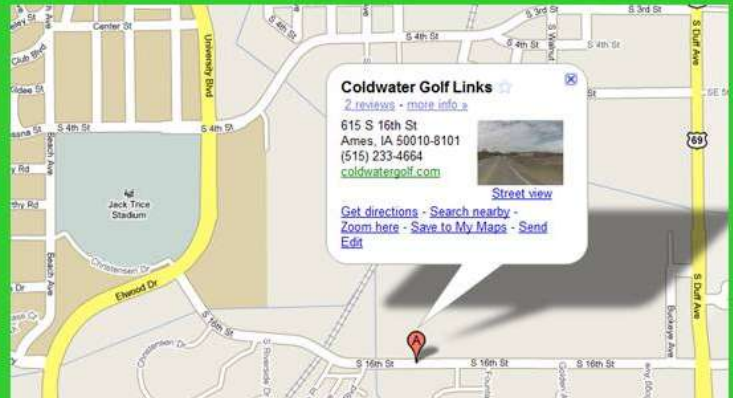
check-in, 9:30 start
