Eldon McAfee will be speaking at the upcoming meeting on Thursday, March 4. Eldon, an attorney with the Des Moines law firm Beving, Swanson and Forrest, was named an Honorary Master Pork Producer at the 2010 Iowa Pork Congress. The award honors those who are passionate and consummate professionals who have roots in agriculture and are deeply committed to protecting the interests of pork producers and helping ensure livestock farmers' success. McAfee serves as legal counsel for the Iowa Pork Producers Association, livestock producers and several other Iowa farm commodity groups. He earned a bachelor's degree in farm operations in 1977 and a law degree from Drake University. Key points Eldon will be touching on are the appropriate steps for how to get into law school and how to be successful in doing so.

Ag Business Alumnus Mary Holz-Clause will be serving as our March Meet the Prof. Mary is the associate vice president for Iowa State University Extension and Outreach. In this capacity, Holz-Clause leads university-wide initiatives such as economic development, strategic resource management and the global extension program. Current global programs are under development in Nigeria, Turkey, Tanzania, China and India. She also oversees ISU Extension's budget and personnel in the absence of the vice president. She continues to serve as co-director of the Agriculture Marketing Resource Center (AgMRC), where she has served since 2001.

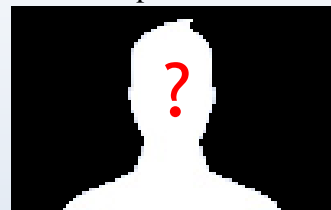
